It is very important that the first person at the club to receive a Criminal Records Bureau (CRB) check is the Club Welfare Officer. It is vital, therefore, to establish and confirm the identity of the Club Welfare Officer.

Please read this carefully and ensure that all sections are completed and returned with the completed CRB disclosure application form and original documentation.

**This section should be completed by a club official** who has known the Club Welfare Officer for at least a year. Ideally the club official should be the club secretary or club chairman.
